

Below is a transcription of the audio file of the Catechism Class given 10-17-10

Because it is pretty much the very foundation of our precious Catholic Faith, I have decided to speak a little bit more on the first Article of the Creed on the term “Almighty.” We really have not finished the First Article and I am not sure we will get to the Second Article yet today. Everything in our lives depends upon how much we love God at the moment of our death. That is what our eternity will depend upon. One of the greatest means of increasing in sanctifying grace is to really know God. The more we know God, the better we can love Him. That is why the term “Almighty” is used in the Creed, although all of God’s perfections are perfect. It could have said I believe in the Father “all loving,” or the Father “all just,” Father “all-knowing” and so forth; but, the word “Almighty” is used.

At least in my case, the more you think about how powerful God is and that nothing is impossible to God, as we recall to mind every day when we pray the second joyful mystery of the Rosary, when the angel told Mary that your cousin, Elizabeth, was with child because nothing is impossible with God. So, as we think about all of the many things that the Creed says, the word, “Almighty” alone is mentioned as it says here in the book. In my opinion, at least, when we realize how powerful and almighty God is, that certainly increases our faith. When we realize that God created all things and keeps them in existence and every moment preserves His entire creation, then it makes it easier to believe that God loves us, God knows everything, and God will take care of us. It increases our hope that we will obtain grace here and life everlasting.

Because God is “Almighty,” He has to be all truthful and can neither deceive nor be deceived. Then, we simply state as the most basic part of our precious Catholic Faith, and realize that God told us He would grant us the graces necessary for our salvation. Every day that we pray our Mass prayers, we recall that by reading the last Gospel -- God enlighteneth every man that cometh into this world (the beginning at St. John’s gospel). God enlighteneth us and, we know from St. Paul, God gave sufficient grace to every man to save His soul.

So, just by realizing how powerful God is and that He is almighty, it increases our faith, hope, and charity. It especially increases our charity towards our neighbor to the extent that we realize we are all God’s creatures, and it makes it easier and more simple to believe that everyone on earth is (so to speak) our brothers and sisters in Christ and that God loves them. We are all the work of God. As mentioned in an earlier class, comparing the books, the book does not have anything to say whether it be black or white or brown or yellow nor what language it will be written in or what size it is, and all of those many things. We are not the ones who choose who our parents will be, what nationality we will be, where we will be born on this earth, and those many things. Therefore, we should never have prejudice or ill feelings against another because of the way God created them.

So again, just by realizing that God is almighty, all of these things come to mind as well as the fact that it increases our justice. We will be just to all men and we will realize that God judges just judgments. When heavy crosses and contradictions come across our path during life, if we only pray the Creed, I believe in God, the Father Almighty, and realize what that simple word means (“almighty”), then we can easily understand how God judges just judgments because He knows all things. There is nothing hidden from Him. Every circumstance is laid open to Him. There is not the teeniest atom of His creation that changes position (and so forth) without God knowing it. He knows all the circumstances, and therefore, He gives us just as much ability as we are supposed to have to obtain that degree of holiness that is God’s holy will that we reach.

So, if we are deprived of Mass and Sacraments at this time because God knows all the circumstances (why we are doing what we are doing in praying and not taking part in non-

Catholic services) and God is all just, He judges just judgments. If we truly keep His commandments, we can still obtain a very high degree of glory for eternity. By praying and realizing that God is almighty, it also makes it easier to increase our love of God, and with that increasing of love of God, it also, of course, helps us to obey and keep His commandments. We know from the Sacred Scriptures that those who keep God's commandments will enter into eternal life. That is the purpose of why God created us – to know, love, and serve Him in this world; that we may be with Him forever in the next.

So, once more, when you have crosses or contradictions and have free moments in your life when nothing is demanding your mental capabilities in a different way, take time to stop and reflect upon *God is almighty* and it will help you increase in practically every virtue.

After the "Almighty," the Catechism goes on to explain the "Creator of Heaven and earth." I am not going to unmute the lines, but how many of you know what are the first three words that open up the Sacred Scriptures? They are the same three words that open up St. John's gospel; "In the beginning." "In the beginning God created Heaven and earth ..." I believe you will find to be the first verse of Sacred Scripture. In St. John's gospel – "In the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God and the Word was God."

So what happened in the beginning? Well, as we pray here in the Creed – in the beginning God created. What was before the beginning? Have you ever asked yourself that question? What was before the beginning? The sacred evangelists and those who wrote the gospels and the Sacred Scriptures had to begin somewhere, so they simply stated – "In the beginning". But, please take time to reflect upon that God existed and God always was. He had no beginning; "I am Who am."

Wait a minute folks! I said stop and think about it. God had no beginning. God has loved us from eternity. These are the mysteries of our Faith. No human mind can understand how long eternity lasts. So, we (to some degree) understand that God loved us from eternity. He only began creation more or less six thousand years ago. Well, how many endless ages has God loved us? That is the way Moses began the book of Genesis – "In the beginning."

Well, in the beginning there was nothing and that is why this Catechism goes on to explain it - for God formed the world not from materials of any sort, but created it from nothing and that not by constraint nor necessity, but spontaneously, and of His own free Will. Nor was He impelled to create by any other cause than a desire to communicate His goodness to creatures. Being essentially happy in Himself, He stands not in need of anything, as David expresses it; "I have said to the Lord, Thou art my God, for Thou hast no need of my good." It was His own goodness that influenced Him when He did all things whatsoever He would. So in the work of creation, He followed no external form or model, but contemplating and, as it were, imitating the universal model contained in the divine intelligence, the supreme Architect, with infinite wisdom and power, attributes peculiar to the divinity, created all things in the beginning. He spoke and they were made. He commanded and they were created.

So what do those words mean to us? God did not make us to increase His own happiness and glory. God created us to communicate His goodness to us. So reflect upon what the Creed tells us. Our precious Faith in the Creed is what God tells us to believe. God created us for the purpose of communicating His goodness to us, to creatures. Think of all the other creatures God created just to show forth His goodness to us. He created all those things that we use to keep ourselves alive: all the food, the shelter, and the many things we have. So, the purpose is to show forth His goodness.

Once we reflect upon that, it should turn our hearts at least to show forth gratitude to God. That is probably one virtue that (speaking generally of how the world is) they do not return thanks and gratitude for the many blessings God bestows upon them. Let that never be what God might accuse us of from this day forth in our lives – that we are ungrateful for the many innumerable things that God has bestowed upon us that He created for our better being and welfare.

As we have just reviewed here, God always was, and He had no beginning. This is why Catholics believe that God created the world and it did not happen the way that Darwin teaches with his big bang theory. We do not believe in evolution. The very first verse of Sacred Scripture tells us God created Heaven and earth. We believe basically because God is Almighty, the eternal Truth. He spoke and it was made; He commanded and they were created. We believe it because God said it. Therefore, all of these erroneous beliefs and theories about evolution (and so forth) are rejected. Either we believe not only in God, but we believe God. If we believe God and what is told to us by His infallible Church, then we have to reject the false heresy, the evolution theories, and all of the other things pertaining to that situation.

Just look again at the perfect order in the universe. Remember again how Jesus Christ was speaking and he told the parable or mentioned how the bird does not fall to the ground without your heavenly Father knowing it; that the heavenly Father feeds every one of His birds; how little value the sparrows have, yet not one of them falls to the ground without your Father knowing it. So, reflect upon that verse of Scripture for a moment and see how the heavenly Father creates enough insects and worms and seeds and fruit trees and animals to produce enough meat to feed those birds who eat meat for a living. Think again of all the billions and trillions (and whatever numbers come after that) of things that God arranges every day this world is in existence. He daily arranges incalculable things just to take care of His many birds, let alone the rest of creation.

Think of how God created everything in such perfect order that He makes enough males and the exact amount of females to keep everything in order throughout the whole universe; how God knows how many insects He has to make to feed the birds; how many fruit trees he has to raise so the birds have some fruit to eat. We could go on in that subject line for a long time, but those are the things you can reflect upon on your own; realizing again, these proofs will bring an increase of faith, hope, charity, confidence, and all of the other virtues.

Then the Creed goes on to remind us that there are not three Almighty's, but one Almighty. Again, I will not unmute the lines to ask, but how many of you know the liturgy of the Church well enough to know what day of the year the clerics still pray the Athanasian Creed? I believe it used to be prayed all the time during the hour of prime, but now it is not prayed every day and every Sunday of the year. The Athanasian Creed is prayed on Trinity Sunday. That is a very important Creed for us, and it is in there that St. Athanasius reminded us that as we say the Father is God, the Son is God, the Holy Ghost is God; yet there are not three gods, but one God. So in like manner, we confess that the Father is Almighty, the Son Almighty, and the Holy Ghost Almighty; yet, there are not three Almighty's but one Almighty.

So, we see again, in praying the Apostles Creed as explained here in *The Catechism of the Council of Trent*, everything is in uniformity with all the Creeds of the Church. I would recommend that you review the Athanasian Creed from time to time, because as it closes (and I do not know the exact words right now), those who do not believe everything in this Creed cannot obtain eternal life.

To the Father, in particular, we call Almighty because He is the source of all being, as we also attribute wisdom to the Son because He is the eternal Word of the Father, and goodness to the Holy Ghost because He is the love of both. These, however, are similar appellations and may be given indiscriminately to the three Persons, according to the teaching of Catholic Faith. So, of course, the mystery of the Blessed Trinity is the great mystery of our precious Faith, and no one can understand it because it is a mystery. As we speak of God the Father Almighty, it does not mean that the Son and the Holy Ghost are not almighty, because everything that you can say of one Person of the Trinity you can say of the other.

Speaking of the "Creator of Heaven and earth," it talks about: as it was His own goodness that influenced Him when He did all things whatsoever He would. So, in the work of creation, He followed no external form or model, but contemplating (and as it were imitating) the universal model contained in the Divine Intelligence, the Supreme Architect with infinite wisdom and power, created all things in the beginning. He spoke and they were made. The next verse goes on to tell us -- He commanded and they were created.

Then the Catechism of the Council of Trent goes on to explain the words of Heaven and earth. The words Heaven and earth include all things which the Heavens and the earth contain. For besides the Heavens, which is properly called, the works of His fingers, He also gave to the sun its brilliancy and to the moon and stars, their beauty... and that they might be for sign and for seasons and for days and years. He so ordered the celestial bodies in a certain and uniform course that nothing varies more than their continual revolution, nor nothing is more fixed than their variety.

I think it is well to recall to mind that we not only believe in God, but that we should also believe God. Then we come to this verse that we just read -- that they might be for signs and for seasons and for days and for years (from Genesis 1:14). So, it speaks about the sun and the moon and the stars and what regulates the days and the years and the seasons. I am not certain that this is a good time to do it, but I guess I will anyway.

This is in the Creed. This is what we believe. It is the sun, the moon, and the stars which regulate the seasons and the days of the year. This, then, is one of the verses that proves the earth is the center of the universe. It is not the earth spinning on its axis that makes day and night and changes the seasons of the year by orbiting around the sun tilted at that 22.5 degree angle (or whatever the cult scientists and astronauts and people tell us that it is tilted at). No, it is the earth that is the center of the universe and the sun and the moon and the stars all orbit the earth. We believe that because God said it.

There are other things we can also use to increase our faith and our belief in that regard. I think that some of you on this line certainly know that I discussed before this subject of geocentric truth as opposed to the heliocentric lies. This is all part of our Catholic Faith and is part of what the Creed teaches us. In my opinion, when Galileo came along (and somehow got his ideas across that the sun is the center of our particular little universe), then the Church seemed to kind of get watered down in Her doctrines contrary to what all the Fathers of the Church unanimously taught before.

Then, it was hard to prove anything from Scripture because there are over 100 verses of Scripture that support the geocentric truth and I have yet to find one that supports the heliocentric lie. For example, in the book of Josue 10:12: Then Josue spoke to the Lord, in the day that he delivered the Amorrite in the sight of the children of Israel, and he said before them: Move not, O sun toward Gabaon, nor thou, O moon toward the valley of Ajalon. And the sun and the moon stood still, till the people revenged themselves of their enemies. Is not this written in the book of

the just? So the sun stood still in the midst of heaven, and hasted not to go down the space of one day. There was not before nor after so long a day, the Lord obeying the voice of a man, and fighting for Israel.

So what was the voice of the man that God obeyed? Move not, O sun toward Gabaon, nor thou, O moon toward the valley of Ajalon. Josue did not command the earth to stop spinning on its axis. No, he told the sun and the moon to stop going toward the west because, in my opinion, there was probably a solar eclipse taking place at that time.

If you read the first part of this Chapter 10, you will find that Josue was called upon to go over there and fight that battle against the enemies and his army marched all night. They were probably warm and tired, so when they attacked the enemies in darkness they were winning the battle. However, when the sun came up, then they started to lose. Then (in my opinion), there is a good probability that God permitted a solar eclipse to take place at that time in that specific part of the earth. As that solar eclipse came upon that part of the earth, Josue and his army again had the advantage of the darkness and they cooled down and they were winning the battle.

To make that solar eclipse last, Josue had great faith because he believed God. So he commanded -- Move not, O sun toward Gabaon, nor thou, O moon toward the valley of Ajalon. If Josue only needed a miracle to help defeat the enemy, why did he command both the sun and the moon to stop? If he only needed a miracle, commanding the sun alone should have been sufficient to convince his enemies that God was on his side. But no, if there was in truth a solar eclipse taking place at that time, he commanded both the sun and the moon to stop in order that the solar eclipse would continue to produce darkness on that part of earth.

As it goes on here in verse 13 -- and the sun and the moon stood still. It does not say the earth stopped spinning. Is this the inspired word of God or is it not? Do we take the interpretation of the modernists or do we take the interpretation of the unanimous teaching of all the Fathers of the Church? It is because of Scripture verses such as this one from the book of Josue, Chapter 10, that the Church condemned Galileo as a heretic because he did not agree with the Sacred Scriptures as always interpreted by the Church.

So, again, what do we believe? Do we believe God? Many people in the world today say they believe in God, but do they actually believe the sacred inspired words of the Holy Ghost? If they do, then how can they be deceived into believing the heliocentric lie and the teaching of modern scientists?

There is much more to go into, but I think I will just unmute the lines at this time and if anybody has questions, you can simply press that 5, then the star key and I will unmute you individually rather than unmute the entire line and pick up noise. those quotes. We already covered at the beginning of this class one of them -- in the beginning, God created Heaven and earth. It talks about they were for the signs and the seasons.

Let me go here to Genesis 1:1 -- In the beginning, God created Heaven and earth; but wait a minute, God created the earth first because it is the center of the universe. God created the earth first and then built the rest of creation upon and around the earth. As we will see later if we continue this study, God only created the sun (I think) on the fourth day. So what was the earth orbiting around if the sun was not even created until three or four days later?

In Genesis 1:2 it says: "And the earth was void and empty, and darkness was upon the face of the deep; and the Spirit of God moved over the waters." Note that God created the earth before He created any light. Was the earth already spinning on its axis and flying through space at 66,600 miles per hour around some light that did not yet exist?

In Genesis 1:3 -- "And God said: Be light made. And light was made." So, we see that God created the earth before He made the light.

In Genesis 1:4 -- "And God saw the light that it was good; and he divided the light from the darkness."

In Genesis 1:5 -- "And he called the light Day, and the darkness Night; and there was evening and morning, one day." Note that this concludes the first day of creation, because so far He created the light, but as the Book of Genesis tells us, that did not necessarily mean He created the sun.

In Genesis 1:6 -- "And God said: Let there be a firmament made amidst the waters: and let it divide the waters from the waters." The footnote in the Bible tells us: *A firmament*. By this name is here understood the whole space between the earth, and the highest stars. The lower part of which divideth the waters that are upon the earth, from those that are above in the clouds.

In Genesis 1:7 -- "And God made a firmament, and divided the waters that were under the firmament, from those that were above the firmament, and it was so."

In Genesis 1:8 -- "And God called the firmament, Heaven; and the evening and morning were the second day." So again, note that already the second day of creation was ended and the sun still was not created. So why was the earth spinning on its axis and what was it orbiting around if there was no sun?

In Genesis 1:9 -- "God also said: Let the waters that are under the heaven, be gathered together into one place: and let the dry land appear. And it was so done."

In Genesis 1:10 -- "And God called the dry land, Earth; and the gathering together of the waters, he called Seas. And God saw that it was good."

In Genesis 1:11 -- "And he said: let the earth bring forth green herb, and such as may seed, and the fruit tree yielding fruit after its kind, which may have seed in itself upon the earth. And it was so done."

Genesis 1:12 -- "And the earth brought forth the green herb, and such as yieldeth seed according to its kind, and the tree that beareth fruit, having seed each one according to its kind. And God saw that it was good."

Genesis 1:13 -- "And the evening and the morning were the third day."

Then verse 14 can be important (Genesis 1:14) -- "And God said: Let there be lights made in the firmament of heaven to divide the day and the night, and let them be for signs, and for seasons, and for days and years." So this verse clearly shows that it is the sun and moon that regulates the seasons, days, and years -- not a spinning earth flying around the sun.

In Genesis 1:15 -- "To shine in the firmament of heaven, and to give light upon the earth. And it was so done."

In Genesis 1:16 (now here we get into the creation of the light; listen to verse 16) – “And God made two great lights: a greater light to rule the day; and a lesser light to rule the night: and the stars.” There is a footnote in the Bible: “*Two great lights.* God created on the first day, light, which being moved from east to west by its rising and setting made morning and evening. But on the fourth day, He ordered and distributed this light and made the sun, moon, and stars. The moon, though much less than the stars, is here called a great light, for its giving a far greater light to the earth than any of them.” So please note here in verse 16, the Holy Ghost very clearly teaches us it is the greater light, the sun, that rules the day. Now if the earth did spin on its axis as modern heretics want us to believe, then the earth would rule the day, not the sun. If the earth is spinning on its axis, then that would cause morning and evening, sunrise and sunset. If that was truth then the Holy Ghost deceived us and lied to us. Either we believe God, the Holy Ghost, and what it says in Scriptures or we do not. If God, the Holy Ghost spoke the truth here in this verse 16 of the first chapter of Genesis, then it is the sun that rules the day, and the earth is stationary and the center of the universe.

But anyway, either we believe God or we do not in what He is telling us in this verse 16; that it is the sun that rules the day.

The stars were seen two days later by Adam when he was created on the sixth day. How could that be if the closest star is at least two and a half light years away? But, that is what the Scripture tells us. Here in the fourth day the stars were created and Adam saw the stars when he was created on the sixth day. How did the light get from that star if it is as far away as the scientists tell us (two and a half light years away); how did it arrive on earth in time for Adam to see it two days later?

I hope you understand what this verse 16 tells us because it is very important. If the sun rules the day, then the earth cannot be spinning on its axis. They cannot both be true. Either the earth spins on its axis and orbits the sun; (contrary to Sacred Scripture) or the earth is the center of the universe (as the Scriptures tell us in over 100 places). The sun, the moon, the stars all orbit clockwise from east to west over the stationary earth.

In Genesis 1:17 – “And he set them in the firmament of heaven to shine upon the earth.”

In Genesis 1:18 – “And to rule the day and the night, and to divide the light and the darkness. And God saw that it was good.” Know what happened here. The Holy Ghost, the Author of the Sacred Scriptures (the eternal Truth) repeats the geocentric true fact. He did not only say it once; God, the Holy Ghost, wrote this more than one time. The fact is we find it many times. It is the sun and moon that rule the day and night, and God saw that it was good. Nevertheless, the anti-geocentric heretics refuse to believe the Holy Ghost speaking the truth to them.

In Genesis 1:19 tells us – “And the evening and morning were the fourth day.” Note that the sun was not even created until the fourth day. What did the earth orbit around if the sun was not even there? Note that the earth was created first and all of the rest of creation was built around it and placed upon it (so to speak).

Now, there is a big move about the extraterrestrial little funny men coming from other planets or stars or wherever they are supposed to be coming from in the world today. But, think about it a moment. Our precious Catholic Faith tells us that all human beings come from Adam and Eve. So, there are certainly no human beings on these other planets.

What is the one part of all God’s creation that is the most important? It is this earth. This is where Jesus Christ, the Son of God, the Incarnate Wisdom, who we have been speaking about in this first Article of the Creed (and the second Article will be specifically on that) came. He did not go to Mars, Venus, or some planet way out in some other galaxy. Jesus Christ came to earth.

He became man, the Word Incarnate. It is on this earth that His precious Blood soaked into the ground. It is on this earth, the center of the universe, that God put His first human being. It is on this earth that the Blessed Sacrament remains. This earth is the center of the universe.

We all know that scientists have a lot of authority. Most people in the world do not believe God and what He spoke so clearly throughout the Scriptures, but hopefully, we will believe just because (and mostly because), God spoke and it was made. There are a number of things that I could go into (and if that is what you want me to do in another class, I can) that explains the geocentric truth from other means besides just the Sacred Scriptures. But, the main reason to believe it is because God said it and God is the eternal Truth, and what else are we going to believe if we cannot believe in God?

We also know that all of the Fathers of the Church, both the eastern and the west (the Latin and the Greek) – all the Fathers of the Church are unanimous in teaching the geocentric truth, according to what St. Robert Bellarmine wrote. So, we have all of Sacred Scripture, all of the Fathers of the Church, and the liturgy of the Catholic Church as we read in *Mediator Dei* of Pope Pius XII, the Catholic Church teaches us through Her liturgy. I again can provide over 50 different reference sources and quotes from the liturgy (mostly from the Divine Office and the Mass prayers), which also teach us the geocentric truth. Then, there is common sense, right reason, and logic. So, we have these four great supports of our table (so to speak) of our Faith: 1) Sacred Scripture, 2) all the unanimous teaching of the Fathers and Doctors of the Church, 3) the Liturgy of the infallible Catholic Church, and 4) right reason and logic.

If you knock all four legs out from underneath a table, a card table for example, is not it bound to crash? So, if you cannot believe the Sacred Scriptures teach us the truth (although they make reference to the geocentric truth in over 100 places); and you cannot believe that the Fathers and Doctors of the Catholic Church teach the truth; who are you going to quote, and to explain, and to actually believe the Catholic truth yourself? If you cannot believe the infallible liturgy of the Catholic Church (although it tells us in over 50 places that the earth is the center of the universe); and you cannot believe logic and common sense, what can you believe? Who will you believe? The funny scientists? The same kind of guys who want us to believe that hitting the twin towers with two airplanes brought them down in a demolition format? Believe as you want to believe, but I am going to believe the Holy Ghost.

There are many other Scripture verses here (and maybe we will just go over some of them), but in the meantime, I mentioned logic and common sense. I will explain a few of those things at this time.

Imagine yourself being inside of a huge airplane, one of these big commercial airplanes, a 747. It has just been built so they did not put the seats or anything inside the place where most of the passengers will be sitting later. Inside this big airplane now, which has just been built, that is empty inside, we have two small remote control helicopters about maybe the size of a house fly. With new modern technology, they can control the speed of those little helicopters perfectly.

So, let us say we have a white helicopter at the front of the big aircraft and small little black one at the rear of the big aircraft with two fellows controlling them. Both of them take off at exactly the same time, fly the exact same speed at the same height from the front toward the back and from the back toward the front of the big aircraft. Which one of those two little helicopters will get to the other end of the aircraft first? Well, theoretically, they should get there at exactly the same time because it is the same distance and they fly the same speed. So they get there at the same time.



Now, we will bring a huge globe into the center of that big aircraft. I can believe the earth is approximately 8,000 miles in diameter and 25,000 miles in circumference. So, we will have this globe 8 feet in diameter, and now we will take those two little remote control helicopters to an airport down in Ecuador where the equator circles the earth. Let us take the little white helicopter (taking off from the launch pad), and he is going to fly around this 8 foot globe going toward the east in a counter-clockwise flight pattern, and the black helicopter will take off at the same time, but he will be going west around the equator of this big globe. If they both take off at the same time, fly the same distance from the edge of the big globe, and fly at the same speed, they should arrive back at the original airport at exactly the same time. Let us say they both fly one foot per hour.

Then, once they arrive back at the airport, the two helicopters are there ready to take another flight around the earth, this globe. But, this time the globe starts to spin, one foot per hour; the same way the white helicopter is flying in a counter-clockwise motion because that is the way the heliocentric liars want us to believe the earth is spinning on its axis (in a counter-clockwise motion). Now, they take off. If the little white helicopter flies one foot per hour and the earth is spinning one foot per hour in the same direction, obviously, the white helicopter stays right above the airport where he left off. The black helicopter lifts off and he is flying one foot per hour going clockwise toward the west. The earth, the globe, is spinning out from under him at one foot per hour, so he should be making two feet per hour around the globe. Obviously, he will get clear around in 12 hours and get back to the landing point where the white helicopter stayed all of the time.

Now, let us blow this up in reality. If the earth is spinning on its axis, take two airplanes down at the airport in Ecuador. The white jet flies approximately 1000 miles an hour because the earth spins approximately a 1000 miles an hour at the equator if it spins at all, according to the heliocentric liars. So the white jet takes off flying around the earth going east, counter-clockwise; the black jet goes west at the same speed. So, in reality, the black jet would circle the earth in 12 hours. The white jet will be at the front of the airport. Is that the way it is in real life? Absolutely not!

There are time zone differences. For example, you could fly from the east coast (say at New York) towards Seattle (or you go from Seattle to New York); the time zones are different, but flying time is basically the same. That is because the earth is the center of the universe, just as the Sacred Scripture tells us over and over that it is.

So, there is much more to explain why we believe not only in God, but why we believe God; why it is important to study our precious Catholic Faith; that we are not deceived by the heretics and the other people in this world. It has been an hour of time, but before I quit, there is just one quick question.

PH: Here, I will unmute. Do you have a question?

John: Is that me Patrick?

PH: Yes

John: Patrick, I just wanted to make a comment to the listeners.

PH: Could you speak up a little louder if you could, please.

John: Sure, I just wanted to make a comment and ask you to elaborate on something if it is not too far off topic. Many people have been indoctrinated with modern science, and you sent me an excellent video tape on the moon landing hoax. I thought that might be relevant to bring up here for those among the people listening who are not aware that a lot of modern science

today is really junk science. It has been used by the enemy to mislead people and to get us enamored with science, instead of God. Could you comment on that, please?

PH: Yes, thanks for the question. That is one of the main problems we have right now, is that people believe the scientists as if they were God. In my opinion, one reason why we have all this extraterrestrial activity being advertised throughout the world now, and why these scientists are promoting the heliocentric lie or the anti-geocentric truth is that they do not even believe the sun is the center of our galaxy anymore. But in my opinion, it is about the same. These people promote these heresies and errors and it is all part of the plan for the Anti-Christ and the information of the new world order.

They are going to use this technology that NASA puts out to have a blue screen movie to make people get scared that all the extraterrestrial people are coming to earth, trying to unite them, and then that will set many things up for the Anti-Christ. Again, these people believe the scientists as if they had the truth, and as if they were God when, as very briefly explained today, the scientists contradict what is in Sacred Scripture.

That movie that John referred to (the video tape) was actually put out by FOX News (one of them); and FOX News cannot be relied upon to teach the truth, but it did point out simple facts that cannot be true. I do not know how many of you want to stay on the line, but I will just mention one thing. From what I understand, of the astronauts who claim they went to the moon, it was Neil Armstrong who made that first step down and said "one small step for man, one giant leap for mankind." I believe your research will show that on that day they were landing during the first quarter of the moon phases. That means that, according to their statements, the earth and moon were going around the sun counter-clockwise. The moon was coming up directly behind the earth in its so-called orbit around the earth in their (earth and moon) counter-clockwise motion according to the heliocentric liars. The moon was basically coming directly behind the earth in the same direction around the sun that the earth was going around the sun. I am using those terms because that is what the anti-geocentric cosmology liars want us to believe.

So what I am getting at is, if the earth was going at 66,600 miles an hour in its counter-clockwise orbit around the sun, the moon has to stay its exact distance (pretty much so) from the earth, so it is also traveling at 66,600 miles around the sun coming right behind the earth. WELL... think about it a moment! The people who claim they went up to the moon say their little spaceship/aircraft thing was (I think) traveling approximately 2,000 miles an hour or 2,400 miles an hour toward the moon as soon as it got out of the earth's orbit. Well, it is only approximately 239,000 miles to the moon from the earth according to their own statistics of the anti-geocentric liars. So, if it is only 239,000 miles, you divide that by 66,600 miles an hour. 239,000 miles divided by 66,600 miles per hour is 3.588. So, what I am saying is, it is only approximately a 3 ½ hour trip to the moon if you just jumped off the earth and the moon was coming toward you.

What took those astronauts three and a half days to get there? It is only a 3 ½ hour ride. What took them three and a half DAYS to arrive if it is only a 3 ½ HOUR trip to the moon? That is because all the astronauts use geocentric calculations when they figure out that they are going to the moon. If these astronauts actually went to the moon, why did not they tell mankind that the earth is the center of the universe? Because everybody is a liar, much like John just mentioned.

PH: So is there another question? Does (505) 901 have a question? Does (716) 693 have another question or statement?

Caller 3: I am sorry, Patrick. No, I do not. Can you hear me?

Anyway, I do not know if it is clear in what I just mentioned that it is only about a 3 ½ hour trip, but hopefully I can make that clearer to your understanding.

Think of a big 18 wheeler truck going down the freeway, and you are standing there at the edge of the freeway when this 18 wheeler truck goes by. You know that there is a car three and a half miles behind the truck. Both the truck and the car are traveling at 60 miles an hour, so they therefore travel one mile per minute. If the earth truck passes you going 60 miles per hour, you know that the moon car (Mr. Moon in his sports car) will pass you three and a half minutes later, right where that truck just went past you. Those are the calculations.

There is no way that it takes 3.5 days to get to the moon if it is only a 3.5 hour trip away. So those are only a few examples of many things that prove that science, logic, as well as Sacred Scripture, the Liturgy of the Catholic Church, and the unanimous teachings of the Fathers of the Church, are all in agreement that the earth is the center of the universe, and the sun and the moon and the stars all orbit the earth.
