TIME – The Purchase Price of Eternity

Time is the measure of our lives; so much as we lose of our time, so much we lose of the precious span of our life. The future is not ours; we cannot promise ourselves a single moment of time. The present moment is all we can call our own; it passes away in an instant, and once gone, it can never be recalled.

Time is given us that we may secure for ourselves eternal happiness. There is not a moment in which we cannot store up treasures for ETERNITY. Lost moments are therefore like so many LOST ETERNITIES. Our eternal salvation or damnation depends upon the good or bad use of our time, and ETERNITY hangs upon the tiny balance of a single moment.

Time is short and passes quickly! So do the enjoyments, honors, riches, and pleasures of the world. But ETERNITY endures – ETERNITY and the good and evil which it holds – endures forever, without change, without any mixture of ill in its perfect happiness or any alloy of comfort in its perfect misery.

And I say to you: Make unto you friends of the mammon of iniquity; that when you shall fail, they may receive you into everlasting dwellings. (Saint Luke 16:9). To do this, let us take money to drive us into heaven by making us reflect on the length of eternity. *In all thy works remember thy last end, and thou shalt never sin.* (Ecclesiasticus 7:40). Our last end is heaven or hell for eternity. *Man shall go into the house of his eternity.* (Ecclesiastes 12:5). Therefore, I suggest we take a coin that is approximately 1 ¾ inches in diameter because that will make its circumference approximately five and 45/64 inches. The old American silver dollars might be close, although I do not have one here present to measure its exact diameter. If we had a coin that was 5 11/16 inches +1/64 of an inch in circumference, then we could divide it up into 365 measurements of 1/64 of an inch each. If the coin were that size and we rolled it 1/64 of an inch every day it would roll the distance of its own circumference only one time a year. So, take an old American silver dollar and drill a hole through it so that you can hang it on a nail as if it were a picture on the wall.

How far is it from King Cove, Alaska, to Florianopolis, Brazil? It is a very long distance if you are going to travel by land, as we are now going to do with our silver dollar. Take your silver dollar and roll it in the ocean at King Cove, Alaska. By doing so, let us assume that the little hole you drilled in the dollar is filled with a tiny drop of water that never evaporates.

Next, we will transport that small drop of water from King Cove, Alaska to Florianopolis, Brazil by rolling the dollar just 1/64 of an inch every day. By rolling the dollar 1/64 of an inch every day instead of that much every million years, or every trillion years, we will travel at the speed of approximately 5 & 7/8 of an inch every year. Consequently, if we are traveling slightly less than 6 inches per year, how many years will it take to travel from King Cove, Alaska, to Florianopolis, Brazil? Consider that after rolling the dollar 1/64 of an inch each day for 100 years, it is still slightly less than 50 feet from where it started! Reflect also that if the dollar were started on its journey when God created Adam and Eve, but only rolled 1/64 of an inch every 1,000 years, then it would only be about 3/32 of an inch – which is less than 1/8 of an inch from where it started! Nevertheless, even at the speed of 3/32 of an inch in 6,000 years, eternity will last long enough to roll the dollar from King Cove, Alaska, to Florianopolis, Brazil! After that exceedingly, extremely long period of time it takes you to reach Florianopolis, Brazil, you can empty that first, tiny, small drop of water into the ocean. After you have emptied that drop of water out of your silver dollar, you need to make the return trip back to King Cove, Alaska, where you can pick up the second drop of water. Have you calculated yet how many years it took you to make

just *one* round-trip? No, I doubt that you have, and I doubt that man can accurately calculate that number until he will *go into the house of his eternity*. At that time, he may begin to get a slight indication of how long it will be in *the house of his eternity*!

But remember, the silver dollar only made one round-trip so far. Our project and goal are to transfer all of the water from the ocean from King Cove, Alaska, to Florianopolis, Brazil. Who can calculate how many trips it will take to transport all of the water from the Pacific Ocean to the Atlantic Ocean from these two points, traveling slightly less than 6 inches per year, and hauling only one small, tiny drop of water per trip?

Well, has the obvious truth struck you yet? That project will never be done because by the time you make your round-trip going back from Florianopolis Brazil to King Cove Alaska the first drop of water by then could easily be back at King Cove Alaska – and you will need to carry the same drop of water over, and over, and over again, and again, and again! That is how it is, although it takes so extremely many years to make a round trip from King Cove, Alaska, to Florianopolis, Brazil, traveling less than 6 inches per year you will never have enough time to transfer all of the drops of water from the Pacific Ocean to the Atlantic Ocean. Nevertheless, **and please mark this point very well in your mind**, every human being will have enough time in *his house of eternity* to carry every drop of water in the oceans from the Pacific Ocean to the Atlantic Ocean. It will be a never ending job; and whichever house we enter for eternity will never end! Let every one of us ask ourselves every time we see any money, “will I be in my house for eternity in heaven or in hell?”

To reach a high degree of glory for eternity reflect very often on how much God loves us and how long God has already loved us! “The Lord hath appeared from afar to me. Yea I have loved thee with an everlasting love, therefore have I drawn thee, taking pity on thee.” (Jeremias 31:3)

“If thou wilt enter into life keep the commandments.” (Matthew 19:17) Only an un-repentant mortal sin will send you to hell for eternity, nevertheless billions of people live in mortal sin, because they do not think about how long eternity will last.

Which of you can dwell in the devouring fire – and that forever? “Enter ye in at the narrow gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way that leadeth to destruction, and many there are who go in thereat. How narrow is the gate, and strait is the way that leadeth to life: and few there are that find it!” (Matthew 7:13, 14)

“The sinners in Sion are afraid, trembling hath seized upon the hypocrites. **Which of you can dwell with devouring fire? Which of you shall dwell with everlasting burnings?**” (Isaias 33:14).
