
Public Land Survey System (PLSS) map of the United States

From the Pacific Ocean to Lake Michigan, there are approximately 89 squares. Similarly, from the bottom of Arizona to the Canadian border, there are about 49 squares. This means that a significant portion of the United States is covered with a grid-like pattern, resembling graph paper. Even areas without visible squares could be mapped using the same <u>SQUARE</u> system of townships and sections of land.

Especially if you believe the earth is shaped like a sphere, obtain a supply of 1-inch square peel-and-stick stickers and then stick them to a bowling ball without trimming any of the stickers, without leaving any gaps between the stickers, without any of the stickers being wrinkled, and without overlapping any of the stickers!

{1} Do you agree that no power in heaven, on earth, or in hell can cover a sphere, <u>regardless</u> <u>of the size of the sphere</u>, with square stickers, ensuring there are no gaps and that no sticker is overlapped, wrinkled, or trimmed?

Take a moment to do a little research, and you will discover a fascinating fact. Every country on earth, without exception as far as I could find out, is divided into square miles or square meters – or at least it could be. This means that a section of land, regardless of its location, is one SQUARE mile. The United States, like many other countries, is laid out into sections of land, all using the same square system. It is a common practice that has been in use for centuries. Not long ago I visited with some professional, licensed surveyors. They told me that with their modern precise equipment and technology, they can be accurate within less than 1 inch tolerance when determining that the sections of land are square.

- {2} Do you agree that surveyors could not lay out the earth with square stickers (square miles or square meters of land) if we live on a sphere because you can **NOT** cover a **SPHERE** with squares?
- {3} Do you agree it is only lies and propaganda attempting to make us believe that surveyors can cover a huge sphere with squares when nobody can cover **ANY** sphere with squares?
- {4} Do you agree that something is very, very wrong with all the propaganda we have been told attempting to make us think we live on a sphere-shaped surface?
- {5} Do you agree St. Thomas Aquinas wrote the truth when stating (Q.109, Art. 1, Pt II-II): "By TRUTH we FAITHFULLY represent things as they are, were or will be"?
- 1st Known Truth: The Public Land Survey System (PLSS) map of the United States shows the truth. It faithfully represents how things are and it proves that surveyors are capable of dividing this country into square townships and square sections of land.
- 2nd Known Truth: every continent of land on earth has been or could be divided up into square townships and square sections of land.
- St. Thomas wrote the truth in Pt. II-II, Q. 168 Art. 4: "I answer that, in human affairs whatever is against **reason** is a sin."
- <u>3rd Known Truth</u>: it is against reason to think that you can cover a sphere with square stickers, ensuring there are no gaps and no sticker is overlapped, wrinkled, or trimmed.

In the *Summa*, Q. 14 Art. 2 Pt. II-II, St. Thomas Aquinas lists and distinguishes the six kinds of **sins against the Holy Ghost**, viz., despair, presumption, impenitence, obstinacy,

resisting the known truth, envy of our brother's spiritual good.

- <u>4th Known Truth</u>: Refusing to believe the truth namely, that no one can cover a sphere with square stickers, ensuring there are no gaps and no sticker is overlapped, wrinkled, or trimmed is resisting the known truth, which is a sin against the Holy Ghost.
- {6} Do you agree that it is against reason to believe and teach that any human can cover a bowling ball or any other sphere with square stickers, ensuring that no sticker is overlapped, wrinkled, or trimmed?

Pope Leo XIII teaches in *Divinum Illud Munus*:

He who resists the truth through malice and turns away from it, sins most grievously against the Holy Ghost.

Remember that Jesus Christ and the Holy Ghost warned us in Saint Matthew 12:32:

"He that shall speak against the Holy Ghost, it shall not be forgiven him, neither in this world, nor in the world to come."

There are questions regarding the idea that we live on a more or less flat earth – for which I do not have an answer at this time. However, I have even more questions, and evidence, and serious reasons showing we do not live on a sphere – for which no one has sent me logical answers.
